





2013 Strategic Implementation Plan of EIP Raw Materials

Objectives:

In support of the EU integrated strategy "Raw Materials Initiative" (2008), the European Innovation Partnership on Raw Materials (2012) and the Circular Economy Package (2015)

- Enhance and strengthen the synergies, coordination & collaboration of EU and non-EU funding organisations
- 2. Support and **promote R&I cooperation**
- 3. Improve the efficiency and impact of human and financial investment in R&I activities
- 4. Reduce the fragmentation of R&I funding across Europe and globally

Centralised international evaluation of submitted proposals.




2016-2022

- Organise/participate in joint workshops, matchmaking events with other Ministries and funding agencies


ERA-MIN Joint Calls

<u>SCOPE</u>: demand-driven research and innovation on primary and secondary resources of metallic, construction and industrial minerals and substitution of Critical Raw Materials in a circular economy approach.

Coordination Unit (CO)

Who? the network coordinator (FCT).

Role? contact person for the EC, the ERA-MIN 2 partners, and the external queries; follow very closely the progress of tasks and ensure the delivery date of deliverables.

Advisory Board (AB)

Who? representatives of the 10 relevant initiatives and projects with whom ERA-MIN 2 would like to establish a close cooperation Role? mutual benefit for guidance on the research priorities of the joint calls to ensure that it reflects the EU industrial, political and societal needs.

Network Steering Committee (NSC)

Who? 21 ERA-MIN 2 partners who share equal rights and votes.

Role? is the decision-making body who keep all partners informed about the work progress.

Executive Board (EB)

Who? all WPs and task leaders who prepare documents, surveys, other supported by a group of 4-6 partners called task forces.

Role? Prepare the NSC meetings where the work progress of WP and tasks are presented.





Call Steering Committee (CSC)

Who? Composed only by the funding organisations contributing financially with national or regional funds to the Joint Call

Role? Supervises the whole Call procedure and agrees on the final list of proposals recommended for funding.

Scientific Evaluation Board (SEB)

Who? Composed of independent international recognised scientific experts appointed by the funding organisations

Role? Peer-review the proposals submitted to the Joint Call. SEB members will not submit or participate in proposals within this Call and must sign declarations of confidentiality and of conflict of interest.

Joint Call Secretariat (JCS)

Who? Composed by 2-5 representatives of the funding organisations

Role? Implements the submission, evaluation and selection procedures of the Joint Call and the follow-up phase until the funded projects and all reporting requirements have ended. Handles the communication with the applicants, the reviewers, the JCS and the beneficiaries of funded projects.


Expected outcomes

ERA-MIN 2 network

- 1. a public-public platform for knowledge sharing
- 2. ensure an optimised resource allocation,
- 3. a widespread dissemination,
- 4. facilitate a long-term collaboration between R&I programmes in the raw materials sector beyond Horizon 2020.

3 Joint Transnational Calls

- an attractive tool to internationalise the national/regional R&I community in the raw materials sector across Europe and globally
- 2. complement other EU funding instruments (Horizon 2020; EIT RawMaterials.
- 3. Constitute a Raw Materials R&I programme, monitor and facilitate the uptake of R&I results by end-users and/or society
