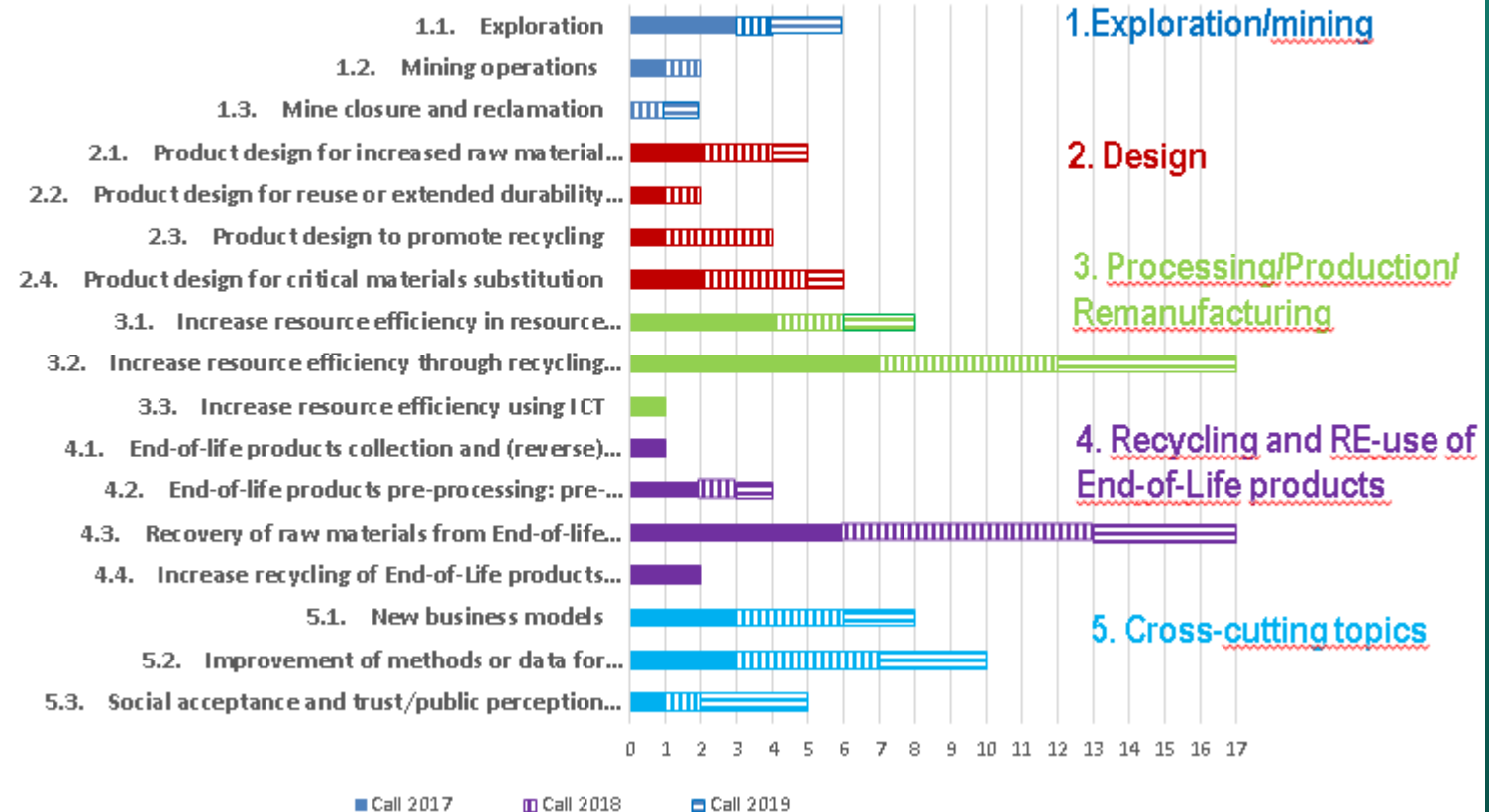

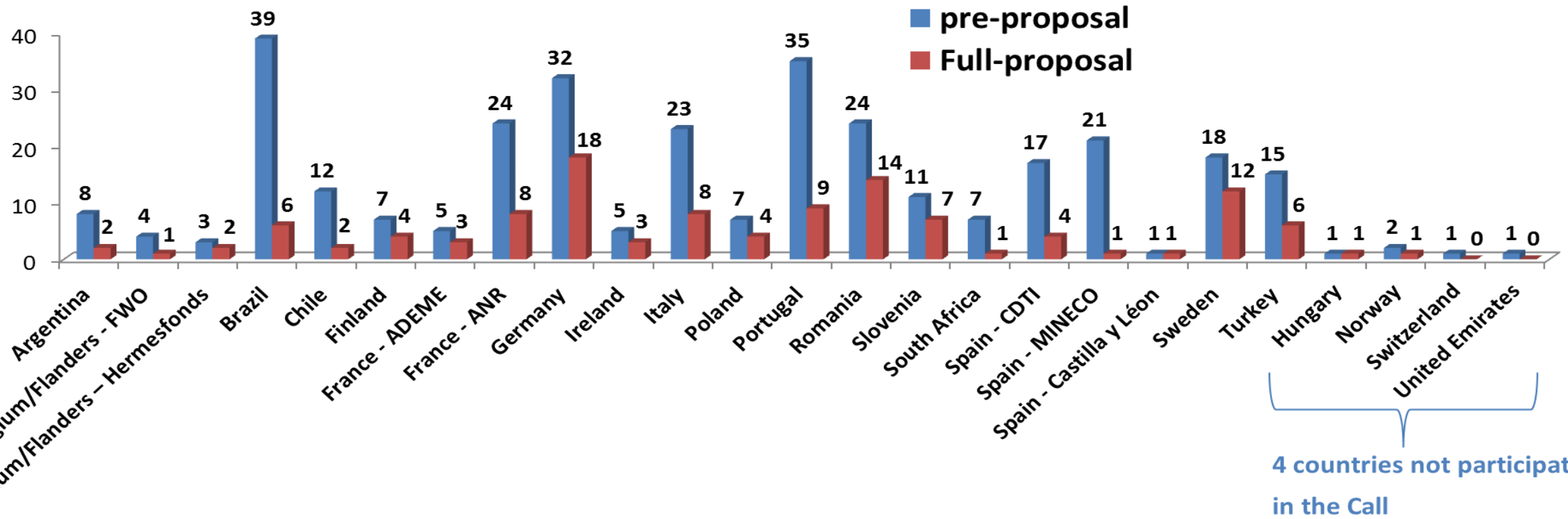

## ERA-MIN Joint Call 2017 – proposals submission by country



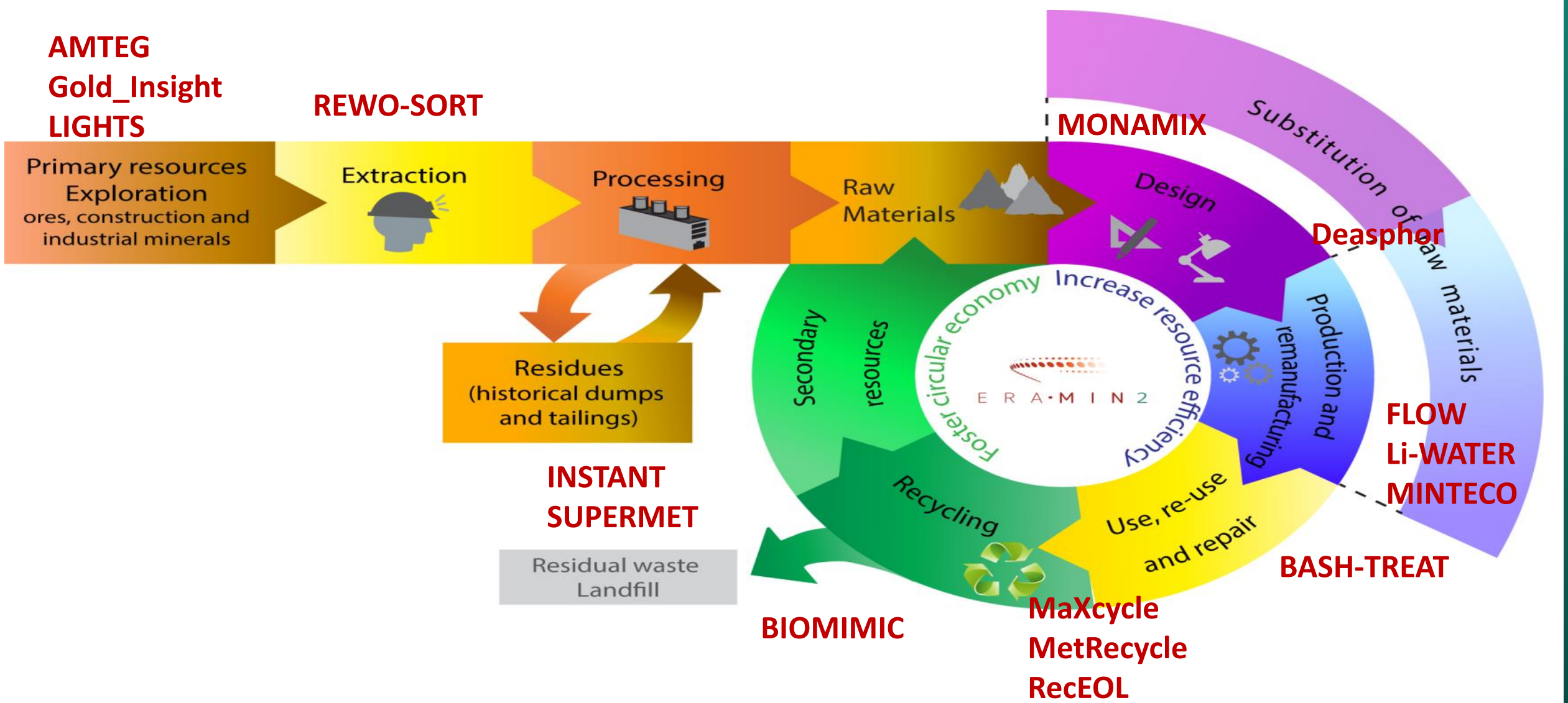


## Partnerships established between partners of the 16 funded projects

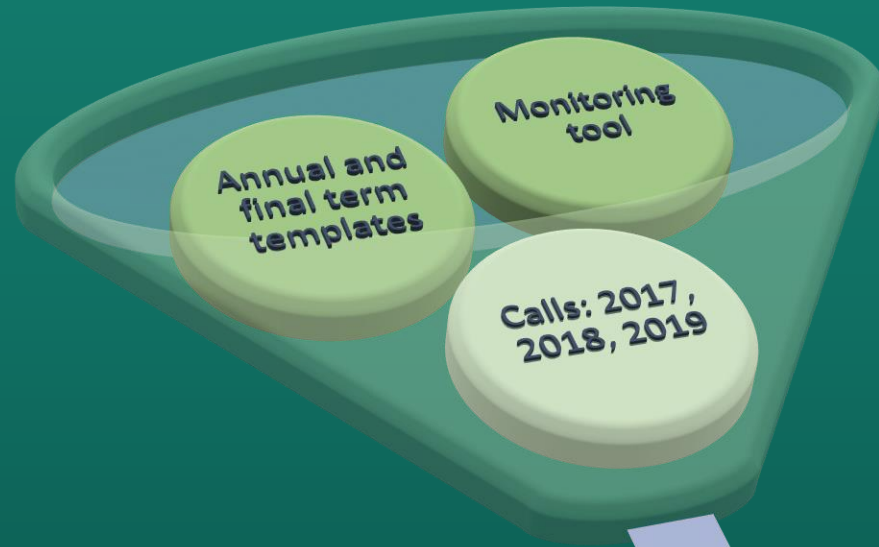

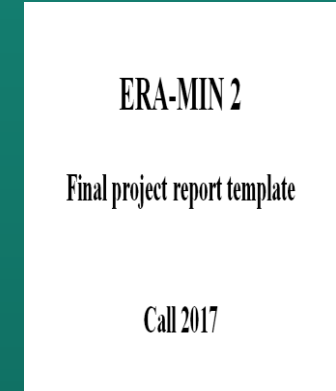
# ERA-MIN Joint Call 2017 – thematic areas addressed by funded projects



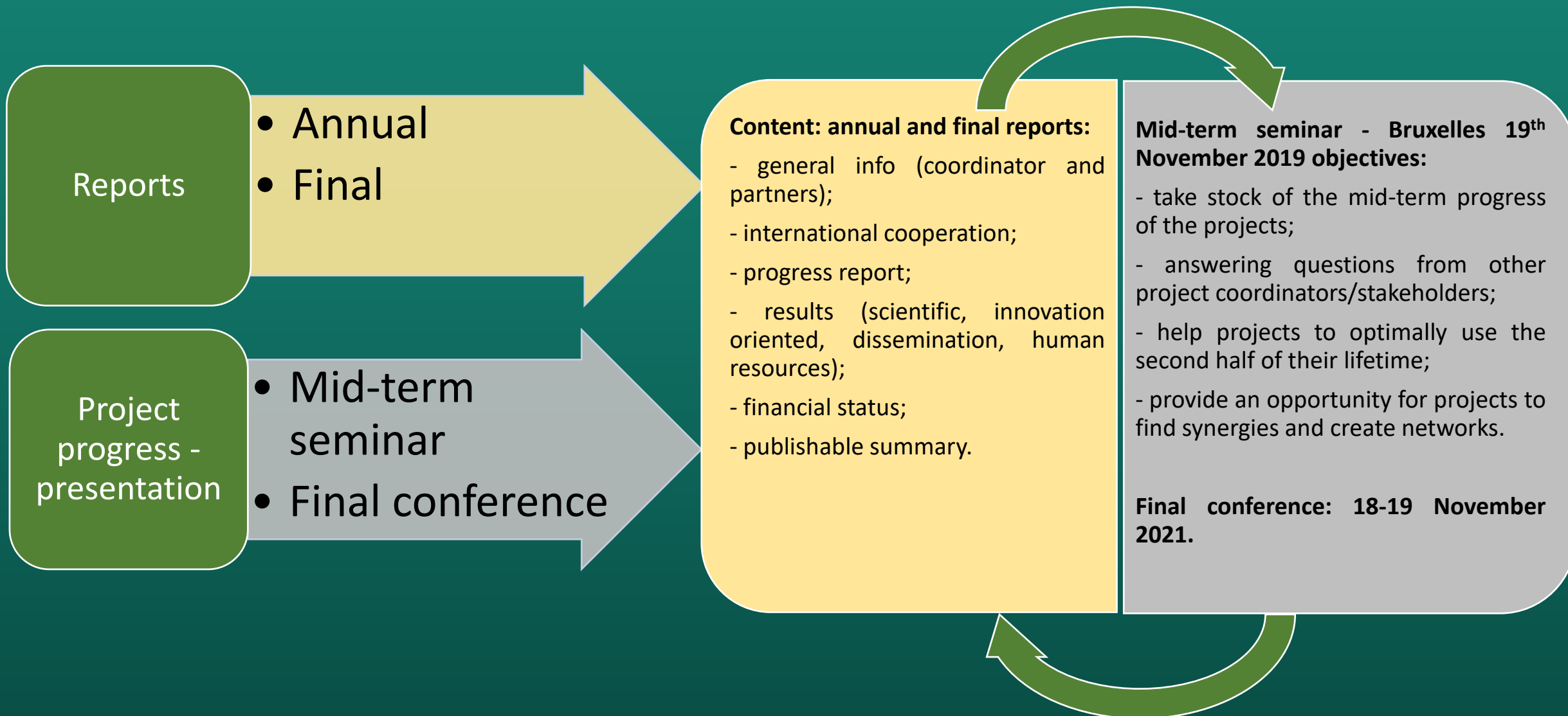
## Monitoring and assessment of funded projects from the co-funded and additional calls

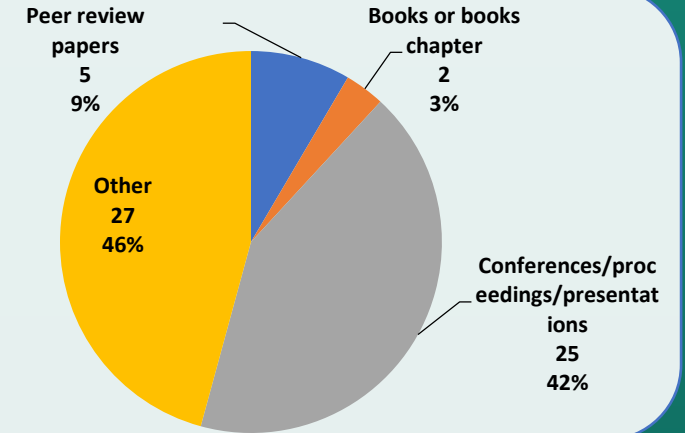






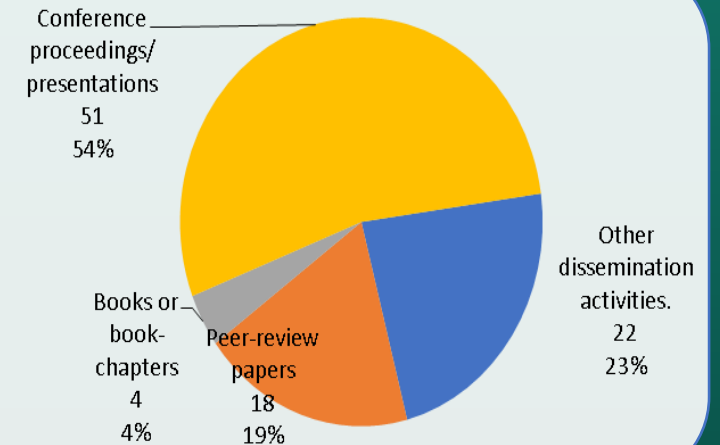
## 1<sup>st</sup> Annual Report

- 7 projects declared **fully achievement** the objectives, 9 with only **minor deviations**.
- 5 peer reviewed publications
- 2 books or book chapters
- 25 conferences/proceedings/presentations
- 27 other outputs (poster presented in conferences, info-days, master thesis etc.)
- 31% of staff are young researchers
- 5 permanent and 48 temporary jobs
- 3 patents, 1 licence were submitted for approval.



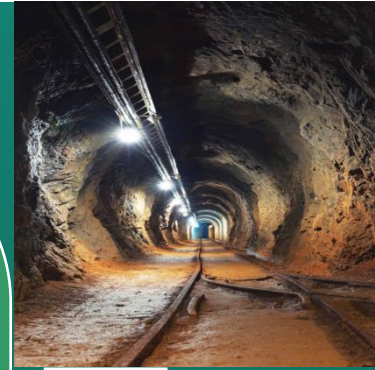
## 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual report

- projects reported **deviations due to Covid** (they will be on track after extensions)
- 18 peer-review papers were reported
- 4 books or book-chapters
- 51 conference proceedings/presentations
- 22 other outputs
- 25% of staff are young researchers
- 9 permanent and 34 temporary jobs created
- 4 patents submitted for approval and 1 in preparation.

### Call 2017

**ERA-MIN Joint Call 2017 on Raw materials for sustainable development and the circular economy**, launched on 1st February 2017, was focused on needs-driven research on non-energy, non-agricultural raw materials addressing one or several areas of the circular economy. **16 top-ranked proposals are recommended** for funding by the Call Steering Committee (CSC), requesting a total of 12.3 million € of public funds and with total costs of 16 million €.
