**ERA-MIN 3** comprises a progressive, innovative and flexible pan-European network of 25 public research funding organisations from **15 EU MS countries** (BNSF – Bulgaria; TA CR – Czech Republic; Business Finland – Finland; ETAg – Estonia; ADEME – France; ANR – France; JÜLICH – Germany; GSI – Ireland; MUR – Italy; NCBR – Poland; FCT – Portugal; UEFISCDI – Romania; CDTI – Spain; AEI – Spain; SAS – Slovakia; MIZS – Slovenia; Vinnova – Sweden), **3 EU MS regions** (Hermesfond – Belgium/Flanders; FWO – Belgium/Flanders; SPW – Belgium/Wallonia; CFNA – Spain/Navarra), **one EU Associated country** (TUBITAK – Turkey), and **three non-EU countries** (PRIMA-Québec- Canada; DSI - South Africa and FINEP – Brazil).

Built on the experience of the EU project ERA-MIN (2011-2015) and ERA-MIN 2 (2016-2021), **ERA-MIN 3** aims to support the objectives of the European Innovation Partnership on Raw Materials (EIP RM), the EU Raw Materials Initiative and further develop the raw materials (RM) sector in Europe through funding of transnational research and innovation (R&I) activities, fully aligned with initiatives to support the EU's transition to a Circular Economy in many fields, such as the Circular Economy Action plan, the Battery Action Plan, and the European Green Deal, by moreover answering to the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals. This will be achieved through one EU co-funded call for R&I proposals in 2021, one additional call in 2023 and a potential third one, designed and developed specifically for the non-fuel, non-food raw materials sector.

**ERA-MIN 3** scope of the joint transnational calls is needs-driven research on non-fuel, non-food raw materials (**metallic**, **construction and industrial minerals**) that clearly demonstrate potential to promote the sustainable and responsible supply, exploration, extraction, processing technologies, production, consumption and recycling of primary and secondary minerals and metals, as well as substitution of critical raw materials, in a circular economy. There is a focus on resource efficient production and recycling that has low environmental impact and is economically feasible in the short-term. A crucial challenge is to consider societal impact and public perception, health and safety issues related to the different stages of the whole raw materials value chain. New business models and digital technologies will be crucial for transferring research results to the market.

#### Publishable summary:

The ERA-MIN Joint Call 2023 is the additional joint call of the ERA-NET Cofund ERA-MIN 3, officially launched on the 7th of December 2022. To promote visibility and attract interest to the call, in cooperation with WP5, the call was promoted at both international and national/regional level, via the ERA-MIN 3 website and different social media platforms, as well as the partners usual channels of communication to potential applicants, and to all relevant groups of stakeholders. Additionally, promotion through presentations at relevant events has also been carried out.

#### 1 INTRODUCTION

Effective promotion and communication is one of the key actions to make a call for proposals a success. From the experience of ERA-MIN 1 and 2 and the previous calls the consortium learned that an enticing set of dissemination materials and activities is essential to better raise awareness about the project and to promote the calls for proposals to potential applicants.

ERA-MIN3 has widely promoted the EU additional joint call 2023 through an international, open and virtual Call Launch Event, promoted and published via ERA-MIN3 communication channels (website and social media such as twitter, LinkedIn and Youtube), using attractive promotion materials such as a promotional video, a call leaflet, a call announcements and presentations.

These materials have been available to all partners of the ERA-MIN3 consortium, which is thus committed to promote the additional call at national/regional level via their usual communication channels to potential applicants in close cooperation with related stakeholders. Therefore, the additional call was widely publicized to attract interest from all relevant groups of interested parties (i.e.): research community related to non-energy non-agricultural raw materials, the Industry, Horizon 2020 National Contact Points, technology platforms, international cooperation projects on R&I, program owners, program managers, and R&I funding agencies.

The ERA-MIN3 consortium approached these target groups via multipliers, intermediaries, and facilitators such as: ERAMIN3 website, international call launch event, national webinars, partners' websites and social media, newsletters, events related to raw materials research taking place in partner countries (meetings, info days, conferences, workshops, brokerage events), and through relevant social networks such as LinkedIn and Twitter.



#### 2 PROMOTIONAL MATERIALS

#### 2.1 Promotion Video

Due to the success of the promotional video of the ERAMIN joint call 2021 with more than 2000 viewers on ERAMIN Youtube channel, an ERAMIN Joint Call 2023 promotion video was also recorded. In this short video (1:52) the most relevant information about the 2023 call is summarized: call topics, key dates, eligibility criteria, participating countries, criteria evaluation and contact data.

The video, broadcasted in English, with English subtitles for accessibility and more clarity, presents the following:

- Brief presentation of the ERA-MIN 3 network and scope,
- Call announcement, scope and total budget,
- List of the 5 call topics,
- Presentation of the general eligibility criteria (TRL, who can apply, duration, and participating countries),
- Presentation of evaluation criteria (same as H2020),
- Key dates of proposal submission,
- Contact details and contact points.




Figure 1 Promotional video screenshot

The video has been included in the <u>CALLS</u> section of the website and uploaded on <u>ERA-MIN3 - YouTube channel</u>. The promotional video has been shown in international events such as <u>PDAC 2023</u> as well as in the different infodays organised by the funding agencies. #### 2.2 Call Flyer

A promotional flyer has also been designed, printed, and physically distributed in different events to promote the ERA-MIN Joint Call 2023, as well as the ERA-MIN 3 network and project.

- i) An attractive cover page, that briefly present the ERA-MIN 3 program (project duration and general scope).
- ii) A second page summarizing the general objectives of the ERA-MIN call 2023, budget and five main call topics. Moreover, briefly summarizes the statistics of the ERA-MIN and ERA-MIN 2 transnational funded projects, with the link to access to the full data.
- iii) A third page with information of the key dates of the ERA-MIN 3 upcoming call. It also shows the participating countries and regions, their contact person, and data.
- iv) The project's different social media channels.




Figure 2 First page of the call flyer




Figure 3 Call announcement screenshot in Era Min Website




Figure 4 Call announcement Era Min 3 2023 Call

#### 3 ERA-MIN 3 JOINT CALL EVENTS

#### 3.1 Call Launch Event

ERAMIN 3 CALL LAUNCH EVENT took place online on 14<sup>th</sup> December 2022 from 14:00 to 16:00 (CET). The platform GotoWebinar was used to host the webinar since it allowed the promotion of the event virtually and therefore to be opened to potential applicants worldwide.

The event was split in two main sections. During the short break between sections testimonials and call videos were broadcast.

In the <u>first part</u>, in a 48 minutes long video, Dina Carrilho, coordinator of ERA-MIN 3 from FCT, Portugal, welcomed the panelists and participants and followe with an Introduction to the project. Later on, Tobias Kampmann from Vinnova, Sweden, gave an Overview of the call procedures, explaining general aspects such as: submission, evaluation, proposals selection procedure, important call documents and where to find them. At the end of the first part, Pontus Westin from Vinnova, Sweden, explained the Call Topics and sub-topics in ERA-MIN 3.




Figure 7 Era Min Call 2023 Launch Webinar screenshot, second part

The event was recorded and uploaded on <a href="ERA-MIN3-YouTube">ERA-MIN3-YouTube</a> afterwards.

The event was promoted through ERA-MIN 3 website and social media (LinkedIn and Twitter). with reminders sent twice, 2 weeks and 1 week, respectively, before the webinar which resulted in a high participation The call launch event had over 60 attendees. #### 3.2 National Webinar

Apart from the international ERA-MIN 3 CALL LAUNCH EVENT national webinars have taken place to inform potential applicants about the ERA- MIN Joint Call 2023 and the specific rules and regulations of their respective national funding agencies.

#### 3.2.1 Spanish national ERA-MIN 3 call 2023 informative webinar

On 9th February 2023 (10:00 CET), AEI/Fecyt (Agencia Estatal de Investigación - Fundación Española para la Ciencia y la Tecnología ) organized together with the three regional Spanish agencies Innobasque (Agencia Vasca de Innovación ), IDEPA (Instituto de Desarrollo Económico de Asturias), and CFNA (Comunidad Foral de Navarra), a national webinar to inform the potential Spanish applicants about ERA-MIN 3 Joint Call 2023 requirements.

The platform Gotowebinar was used to host the webinar that counted with more than 80 registrants. During the 1h30min webinar, general aspects about the open Joint Call 2023 and the specific funding conditions of each regional funding agencies were explained. The video was recorded in Spanish and starts with the welcome, introduction, and explanation of the general aspects of ERA-MIN and call 2023 by Jorge Sotelo, on behalf of AEI/Fecyt. It continues with the intervention of Judith de Prado, representative of Innobasque, describing the specific requirements of the regional Agencia Vasca de Innovacion. Afterwards, Silvia Ojer for the Gobierno de Navarra,



explained the regional requirements of Navarra region. Finally, Ana Elena Fernández from Instituto de Desarrollo Económico de Asturias, described the specific requirements of participation for the Asturian companies. At the end of the video, Severino Falcón from AEI, Agencia estatal de Investigación summarized the rules and requirements at national level. The webinar counted with the special participation of Dina Carrilho, coordinator of ERA-MIN 3, who gave the closure speech and final remarks of the webinar, in English.




Figure 10 Era Min Newsletter February 2023



#### 4.2 Partner Search Tool

A new ERA-MIN 3 Partner Search Tool was developed by partner FZJ JÜLICH (Germany) for the EU co-funded ERA-MIN 2021 joint call, and thus it continues to be made available for the ERA-MIN 2023 joint call. The partnering tool helps potential applicants in finding project cooperation possibilities within the ERA-MIN community. It can be used in two different ways: by posting a partner offer/request and/or by searching the list of partner offers/requests posted by other applicants. It is user-friendly and it counts with the possibility to attune the search by country, topic, organization type, and keywords to easily find the partner more suitable for the project consortium. At the publishable date, there were 47 offers posted on the platform.




Figure 11 Partner Search area in Era Min Website




