

The **scope** of the **ERA-MIN Joint Call 2017** is demand-driven research and innovation on primary and secondary resources of metallic, construction and industrial minerals and substitution of Critical Raw Materials, addressing one or several areas of the circular economy.


Call topics:

- Topic 1:** Supply of raw materials from exploration and mining.
- Topic 2:** Design.
- Topic 3:** Processing, Production and Remanufacturing.
- Topic 4:** Recycling of End-of-Life Products.
- Topic 5:** Cross-cutting topics:
 - New business models,
 - Improvement of methods or data for environmental impact assessment,
 - Social acceptance and trust/public perception of raw materials.


Call budget: 15 million Euros

Pre-proposal submission

94 submitted pre-proposals
493 applicants (27% from enterprises)
Total costs: **81.2 million €**
Total requested funding: **61.7 million €**




Submitted pre-proposals per topic




Distribution of pre-proposals by topic and country
