Final Conference ERA-MIN3



With ERA-MIN3 scheduled to conclude in November 2026, the partnership is approaching the end of a highly successful six-year journey, including a one-year extension.

During this period, 31 research and innovation projects have been funded with nearly €28,5 million in public support, strengthening international collaboration and contributing to the sustainable supply of raw materials across Europe and beyond.



A major milestone in this final phase was the **ERA-MIN3 Final Conference**, which took place on 23–24 June 2026 in Stockholm, Sweden, hosted by VINNOVA. The event brought together project partners, research funding organisations, researchers and stakeholders to reflect on the achievements and impact of the partnership.

The conference was held jointly with the Kick-off Meeting of the RAMP Partnership, marking the transition from ERA-MIN3 to the next phase of European cooperation in raw materials research and innovation.

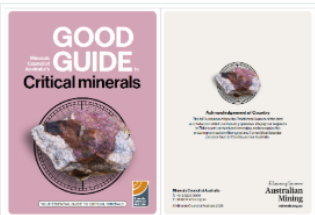

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


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
END of ERA-MIN? No, Engage with RAMP!


